"Poseidon has totally revamped the Powerlift and it is now retailing at £258.00 including VAT. The new Powerlift is attractively coloured black/grey with reflexes on the shoulders as part of the design. It has an integrated, fully ditchable weight system capable of 52k (24lb) loading. Produced in 1000 denier Cordura (Poseidon was the first to use this material) with

ultrasonically welded seams, it is also equipped with a SF 2000 inflation system. The routed shoulder dump is separate to the hose dump and routed bottom dump.

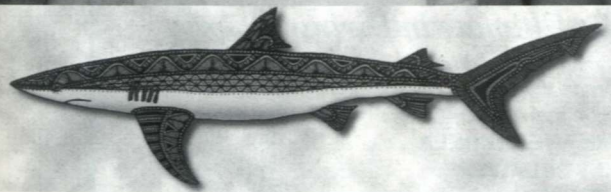
"The jacket has a paddle style cummerbund, depth compensating that can be adjusted according to waist size. Don't



forget the Powerlift's added back pack for extra comfort, twin cam bands, two trim weight pockets, and two expandable velcro closed side pockets each with zip utility pockets."
