## Winter At Lomo

GLASGOW BASED Lomo Watersport has added several new products to their range for this winter.

Their new Neoprene vest is designed to boost the warmth levels of any wetsuit. You wear the vest underneath your existing wetsuit thus adding 2mm of thickness to the upper part of your suit. Also, as the vest has no zip it does not suffer from water ingress and is particularly welcome when used with some wetsuits that do not have a good seal around the zip area.

Wearing this vest often takes away the familiar back chill as

cold water sloshes around in an ill fitting suit. Made of 2mm stretch Neoprene the vest is very comfortable and surprisingly warm. Flatlock stitching throughout make sure there are no uncomfortable seams to rub away at you and the cutaway at the arm is close enough to keep water ingress to a minimum whilst being cut low enough to make movement easy.

Priced at £19.50 this is another cost leading product.

The clever guys at Lomo have also launched a huge drybag to top their existing range of extremely popular drybags. The Monster Bag has a whopping 150L capacity and has a large transparent viewing panel to let you see where those missing socks have gone to.

The bag rolls and clips closed at one end like a conventional bag but has the added benefit of two holdall straps to let you



carry the bag over your shoulder when full of wet gear. The bag was originally designed for in-house use at Lomo for carrying their gear to festivals and outdoor shows but everywhere they went people wanted to buy them.

The bags have been an immediate success with people using them both for keeping dry gear dry whilst travelling on a RIB, and also for keeping dry cars safe from piles of wet diving gear. The monster bags retails at £22.

## Love At First Light

FOLLOWING THE purchase of some major equipment, the German manufacturer of Treble Light Diving Lamps can now build even more parts in-house, resulting in lower production costs. The

company has therefore decided to drop its retail prices by approximately 15% with effect from the Dive Show in Birmingham, which now makes Treble Lights even more affordable and very

competitively priced in the market.

One of Treble Light's latest models is the Silverline MX6 HID at the new price of £330. Measuring only 59 x 200mm it is equipped with a 10Watt HID-bulb and this lamp is offering a burn time of approx. 120 minutes.

Brightness of the bulb can be easily compared with a 35w halogen bulb, but with a light temperature of 5500k. It produces very natural colours and penetrates murkier waters much better than standard halogen bulbs. The light-head can be completely unscrewed, so there is no need to fuss with bulbs and burners when

the need for removal occurs.

The NimH-battery can be charged regardless of its level of charge and charging time is approx. 4 hrs when the battery is completely flat.
