



# **RESULTS SUMMARY**

From the survey results, Eyemouth shore divers are typically qualified and dive mainly from April to October, monthly or bimonthly. They mostly come from the surrounding regions although many also come from the Midlands and Yorkshire partially Sheffield. They dive in groups of 4-9 and nearly half will stay in local accommodation suggesting a good economic benefit for Eyemouth. They recognise the spot for its progressive sheltered shore diving and the quality of diving. They would not want access to the spot to be affected and ask for the development of facilities to enhance the experience.



# MAP OF DIVERS' LOCATIONS



#### THE DIVE SEASON

The season extends from April to October where dive drop by over half going into November. Nonetheless, between 17–28% of divers said they still dive the site from November through to February.
